Academic Session 2023-2024

1. Employment Generation Initiative

Purpose:

In the academic year 2023-2024, the college introduced a forward-thinking employment generation practice designed to bridge the gap between academia and the hospitality and tourism industry. Recognizing the growing demand in this sector, the college organized various career-oriented sessions to expose students to the expanding opportunities in hospitality and tourism. Outcome:

The initiative resulted in tangible employment opportunities for students, as evidenced by the job offers given to 03 students who underwent training programme. While this represents an initial step, it lays the foundation for a broader vocational training framework at the college.

The long-term vision is to inspire more students to explore non-traditional career pathways, thus expanding their employment prospects beyond the conventional academic routes. This successful outcome has generated considerable interest among other students, with an increasing number expressing a desire to pursue similar vocational training in the hospitality sector.

2. "Walk with the Community"

Purpose:

Government College Sainj upholds a core value of community engagement, striving to foster a sense of civic responsibility among its students. The college is committed not only to imparting academic knowledge but also to instilling in its students the importance of giving back to society.
