

Best Practices Implemented at Government College Sainj during the Academic Session 2023-2024

During the 2023-2024 academic session, Government College Sainj implemented two notable best practices that significantly contributed to both the personal and professional development of its students, as well as the well-being of the broader community. These initiatives demonstrate the college's commitment to enhancing the employability of its students and fostering a sense of social responsibility.

1. Employment Generation Initiative

Purpose:

In the academic year 2023-2024, the college introduced a forward-thinking employment generation practice designed to bridge the gap between academia and the hospitality and tourism industry. Recognizing the growing demand in this sector, the college organized various career-oriented sessions to expose students to the expanding opportunities in hospitality and tourism. Industry experts were invited to deliver guest lectures, sharing insights into career pathways, skill development, and industry standards. These interactions provided students with firsthand knowledge and motivation to explore this lucrative field.

Furthermore, a select group of students were offered the opportunity to participate in a one-month paid training program during their winter break. This hands-on experience allowed them to apply their learning in real-world settings, gain practical skills, and make informed career choices. Following the training, two students received formal job offers from the hotel where they completed their internship, choosing to continue working after the training period.

Outcome:

The initiative resulted in tangible employment opportunities for students, as evidenced by the job offers and salary slips attached as documentation. While this represents an initial step, it lays the foundation for a broader vocational training framework at the college. The long-term vision is to inspire more students to explore non-traditional career pathways, thus expanding their employment prospects beyond the conventional academic routes. This successful outcome has generated considerable interest among other students, with an increasing number expressing a desire to pursue similar vocational training in the hospitality sector.

2. Community Engagement: "Walk with the Community"

Purpose:

Government College Sainj upholds a core value of community engagement, striving to foster a sense of civic responsibility among its students. The college is committed not only to imparting academic knowledge but also to instilling in its students the importance of giving back to society. To actualize this vision, the college has implemented a "Walk with the Community" initiative, which seeks to build strong relationships between the college and the local community through student-led outreach programs.

Throughout the academic session, various student organizations—including the CSCA, National Service Scheme (NSS), R&R, Road Safety Club, and Red Ribbon Club—collaborated on a range of community service initiatives. These activities included environmental clean-up drives, road safety

Teacher Feedback Report: 2023-24

Total Responses= 8

- 80% teachers belong to Arts and Humanities
- 20% syllabus is need-based
- 60% teachers are satisfied that the aims and objectives of the syllabi are well-defined and clear to teachers and students
- 80% teachers are satisfied that course/syllabus has good balance between theory and applications

Total Responses= 77

Overall Satisfaction:

Students expressed positive satisfaction with their overall college experience.

[More than 70 percentage of students are satisfied with various aspects of college life, such as academics, extra-curricular activities, and facilities.]

Academic Quality:

Student feedback in regards to quality of faculty teaching methods, their availability, and responsiveness with

- 79.2% students are satisfied with the teachers' approach of teaching
- 87% of students are satisfied with teachers' ability to communicate
- 80.5% of students are satisfied with internal evaluation process adopted by teacher
- 71.4% of students are satisfied with the discussion about performance in assignment in class
- 77.9% of students are satisfied with the teachers informing them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and programmes outcomes.
- 66.2% of students are satisfied with the necessary follow-up with an assigned task to students.
- 79.2% of students are satisfied with the teachers' ability to identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome it.

Positive feedback on Institutional Environment with

- 59.7% students are satisfied with teaching and mentoring process
- 71.4% of students are satisfied with opportunities provided at college for their learning and growth
- 66.2% of students are satisfied with the institution making effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process
- 64.9% of students are satisfied with the efforts made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work
- 79.2% of students are satisfied with the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute.

Result

- The feedback received from the teachers was a more than satisfactory.

Alumni Feedback Report: 2023-24

Total Responses= 18

- 75% are unemployed
- 76.5% are aware of the objectives of the Alumni Association
- 100% agreed that college education helped them to prepare for their better future
- 76.5% have agreed to contribute to the overall improvement of the college
- 43.8% have agreed to contribute academically to the college
- 37.5% agreed to contribute financially to the college
- 75% have attended one meeting of Alumni Association during the 2023-24
- 81.3% agreed that the college invites suggestions from Alumni members on important decisions or planning for the session
- 93.3% agreed that they have made any/some contribution during this session towards the improvement of the college
- 68.8% excellently assess the college
