From 5–9 November 2024, fourteen members of the Mountaineering, Trekking & Adventure Club (10 boys and 4 girls) participated in a five-day joint field exercise with GHNP Ropa. गुल्ज टोपीकल लखन/सैज : राजकीय महाविद्यालय सैज के विद्यार्थियों ने ग्रेट हिमालयन नैशनल पार्क द्वारा आयोजित वन्य प्राणी गणना में भाग लेकर एक सराहनीय पहल की है। इस कार्यक्रम में विशेष रूप से भूक क्लिब और क्लब सोन जिले के वन्य प्राणियों की गणना की गई। जिसमें महाविद्यालय के प्रो प्रदीप कुमार, प्रो प्रदीप कुमार और 14 विद्यार्थियों, जिसमें 10 छात्र और 4 छात्राएं शामिल थीं, ने हिस्सा लिया। गणना अभियान के लक्ष्य विद्यार्थियों को वन्य प्राणियों में विभाजित किया गया था, जिन्होंने जीव संवर्धन, विकास, बहली धार्य और रूनिस्वर जैसे स्थानों पर जाकर क्लू सोन, मरक क्लिब, ब्रडन क्लिब आदि प्रजातियों के वन्य प्राणियों की गणना की। इस कार्य में वन विभाग के वन संरक्षकों ने विद्यार्थियों

का मार्गदर्शन किया और उन्हें विभिन्न प्रकार के पेड़-पौधों, नकलियों, जड़ों-मुट्टियों और जीव-जंतुओं के बारे में गहन जानकारी प्रदान की। यह कार्यक्रम 5 दिन तक चला, जिसमें विद्यार्थियों को प्रकृति और वन्य जीवों को निराल से समझने का अवसर प्राप्त हुआ। महाविद्यालय की छात्राएं, कॉ. सुजाना, ने बताया कि इस प्रकार के कार्यक्रम से विद्यार्थियों को ग्रेट हिमालयन नैशनल पार्क के समस्त जैव विविधता और पारिस्थिति के बारे में ज्ञान प्राप्त होगा, जो भविष्य में उनके रोजगार के लिए लाभकारी सिद्ध हो सकता है। उन्होंने कहा कि इस तरह के अनुभवों से विद्यार्थियों का न केवल पर्यावरण संरक्षण के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ती है, बल्कि यह उन्हें प्रकृति के साथ जुड़ने का अवसर भी प्रदान करता है।
